Heritage Explorers Programme

The National Heritage Board (NHB) has recently embarked on a programme called Heritage Explorer's Programme, which is specially designed with the aim of raising students' awareness and interest in our local and community heritage.

In this respect, NHB has invited students of St Stephen's School to participate in this programme, by role-playing heritage professions such as Curator, Designer, Ambassador, Historian and Educator. By role-playing, students will discover and have better understanding of their family, community and our nation's history and rich heritage.

In line with the school's CCE programme, we wish to give our P1 and P2 pupils the opportunity to share about their neighbours - their customs and traditions, with the rest of their peers.

Furthermore, being a multi-racial society, the pupils can learn more about the richness of the customs and culture of the different ethnic groups in Singapore.

As such, for P1 and P2, we have selected the role of an Educator, for the Heritage Explorer's Programme. The role consists of 5 tasks which complement subjects such as Social Studies, National Education & Character and Citizenship Education. Students need to complete at least 3 out of the 5 tasks, in order to obtain the profession's badges.

Please be informed that P1 and P2 CCE Teachers will assist the pupils with task 3 of the Educator role.

Parents are encouraged to bond with their child during the June holidays by completing at least 2 other tasks with their child, so that the child may receive his Heritage Explorer's Badge.

Your child would need to submit the NHB Booklets in the first week of Term 3, **by 7 July 2017**, if your child would like to work towards a Heritage Explorer's Badge
