## 52<sup>nd</sup> National Day Celebrations and 12<sup>th</sup> Mass Jog

2. We hope to achieve the following objectives of the above-mentioned event. They are :

3. The details of the Mass Jog include the following;
 

Venue	: <b>Angsana Green at East Coast Park Area E2</b>
Assembly Point	: Tent at Grass Area beside Car Park E2
Route	: Refer to the map as attached (approximate Distance: P1 to P3 -1km and P4 to P6 -2km)
Time	: 7.20 am to 9.45 am (Estimated; inclusive of National Day Celebration)
Attire	: Red T-shirt and PE shorts (Track shoes are allowed)
4. Light refreshments will be provided by the school after the jog. Pupils are advised to carry a small bag containing a **PE t-shirt, a small towel, a water bottle and a raincoat.**
5. Pupils are advised not to bring their mobile phones and they are strongly encouraged to label their names on their bags or belongings.
6. The event is compulsory for all pupils. Your child/ward will be required to take his temperature before leaving home in the morning for the Mass Jog. If he is unwell, he should stay at home and is advised to seek medical attention. Your child must inform the teacher of his absence when school resumes on Friday, 11 August 2017.
7. We would like to encourage you to be part of the celebration. You can either jog with your child/ward in this event or volunteer as a Class Manager. Please wear a red T-shirt. Please provide us with the information through the link at <https://goo.gl/AUqVYw> by Wednesday, 26 July 2017.

9. Parent volunteers, who drive, are advised not to park at Car Park F2 but at other nearby Car Parks. This will lessen the congestion at Car Park F2 where the pupils will be alighting.
10. Your child need not report to school on Wednesday, 9 August 2017 and Thursday, 10 August 2017, as both days are public and school holidays respectively. School will resume on Friday, 11 August 2017.
