3. For items listed in Section A, you will need to make payment of **\$ 8.20** in cash or cheque payable to 'St Stephen's School'.
4. For payment by cash/cheque for items in Section A and B (for Singapore Permanent Resident or International Students) submit the amount of **\$20.20** by cash OR issue a cheque payable to 'St Stephen's School'. Please indicate your son's name and class on the reverse of the cheque.
5. Please submit all completed consent forms and cash/cheque payment to your son's Form Teacher by **4 May 2018**. All cheques are to be made payable to "St Stephen's School".
6. Please note that your child not be permitted to participate in enrichment programme/activities if payment has not been made prior to the commencement of the programme/activity.
7. There will be no refund of the programme fees for absentees without valid reasons. For absentees with valid reason, request for refund will be considered on a case by case basis provided the vendor charged on actual day attendance.
